 - Table Talk is a civic engagement strategy led by the Central Florida Foundation to bring people together in conversations about their community and ideas for improvement
 - It involves hosting tables of 8-10 people to discuss topics like the economy, education, health, and more
 - The foundation collects survey data and notes from the discussions to understand perspectives and develop recommendations for leaders
 - Examples of outcomes include the formation of a Black empowerment council in Osceola County and a marketing campaign led by the Samaritan Resource Center
 - The foundation is now moving to a new phase where they will provide grants for other organizations to host their own Table Talk events and discussions
